

Hangklip-Kleinmond Itinerary

DAY 1

Depart from Cape Town: travel on N2-road to Gordon's Bay. Drive along scenic Clarence Drive (R44-road from Gordon's Bay).

Visit Stony Point Penguin colony in Betty's Bay for a guided tour and board walk.

Try something different visit Gaboli Chocolates, try your hand in making your own home made chocolate.

Stop at Harold Porter Botanical Gardens in Betty's Bay for a guided tour. Nestled between the sea and the mountain side, where streams and reflection pools feed the soul, the **Harold Porter National Botanical Garden** is in the heart of the Cape's richest fynbos region. Enjoy a leisurely lunch in the most beautiful setting.

Visit the Kogelberg Nature reserve do a short hike along the Palmiet River.

Visit Kleinmond Harbour where you can visit Art Galleries, Pottery Studios and beautiful little Shops .Also chose on of the restaurants to have a Sundowner or Dinner overlooking the Harbour.

Stay over at on of the Guesthouses; B&B OR Self Catering Accommodation in the Kleinmond area.





DAY 2

Eat breakfast at one of the restaurant in Harbour Road or along the beach front at Kleinmond's Blue flag Beach.

Take a canoe up to Rooisand Nature Reserve were you will encounter wild horses along the way.

Play a game of Golf either at Arabella Hotel & Spa or Kleinmond Gold Club.

Have dinner at one of the restaurants, either in Betty's Bay or Pringle Bay and watch the magnificent sunset in the Hangklip-Kleinmond Area

Sleep over at one of the B&B OR Guesthouses in the Area
