Walk from Hermanus New Harbour along the coast to Grotto Beach where you can have refreshments at Dutchies and get a lift back with one of our many transport service providers. Whale watching from June to November.

Hike to or from the Milkwood Restaurant at Onrus Beach along a path. Easy walking with 2 tidal pools to swim.

Coffee kiosk at Onrus Caravan Park.

60km of linked paths for hiking enthusiasts. The various trails offer magnificent views of Walker Bay, the Hemel-en-Aarde Valley and Maanskynbaai.

Mind the tide!

Bosmans Hermanus has 2 routes on their Hemel-en-Aarde winery property that is just past De Bos Dam. A Wetlands (7km) and Koppie (2km)

Start the hike from Fernkloof visitors centre, or for a shorter 30 min hike at the end of Reservoir Road - just off the Voëlklip Circle.

Enjoy a swim and picnic.

A rocky outcrop in the middle of Hermanus, offering splendid views and is burial place of Sir William Hoy and his wife Gertrude. Archaeologisits have found evidence that indigenous Khosian people inhabited Klipgat Cave on the southern side of the hills.
